

Culture Grams: A Study Around the World

*You will need to create a poster for a country who experienced a **genocide**. The poster will be graded for clarity, visual appeal, organization, and accuracy. The poster (can be done electronically OR handmade) and will need to include information about the genocide that took place in that country.*

1. You will choose one of the following Genocides to study.
2. You will then do a culture gram poster of that country (similar to the one we did at the beginning of the year)
 - a. You will need to include the information that is listed below
3. Then, you will add information to your poster about the genocide that took place either in the country or by the country you are doing your culture gram poster about. You may do bullet points or just a short paragraph explaining what happened (this is entirely up to you).
4. Submission either to tii or an email to me with “Genocide Culture Grams Project” as the subject line
5. Due by June 12th at 11:59pm

Countries/Genocide:

- Herero Genocide (1904-08; Germany/Namibia)
- Armenian Genocide (1915-22; Turkey)
- Holodomor (1932-33; Russia/Ukraine)
- Cambodian Genocide (1975-79; Cambodia)
- Parsley Massacre (1937; Dominican Republic)
- Nanking Massacre (1937-38; China/Japan)

Culture Grams:

Logging into Culture Grams:

1. Go to Ms.Bacon’s library website
2. Click on “Databases and Ebooks”
3. Scroll down and in the bottom righthand corner, you will see “Culture Grams”
4. Click on “Culture Grams”
5. If it asks you to log in, please use the following to do so:
 - a. Username: spartans
 - b. Password: spartans
6. Once you are in, please select “World Edition”
7. Then, find your country and begin!
