



Rudyard Kipling: 1865-1936

- Proponent of White imperialism









Image Analysis

White Man's Burden

- Origin: written by Rudyard Kipling for the Queen's Jubilee (not used).

 Rewrote and sent to Teddy Roosevelt (governor of New York at the time)
- **Purpose:** To suggest how the U.S. should look at its current conflict with the Philippines and Spain
- Content: Your turn
